Who is an Alumni of The Mission Continues Programs?

An Alumni is someone who has successfully completed one of the following programs: the Fellowship Program, Women Veterans Leadership Summit, Women Veterans Leadership Program, Service Leadership Corps, Mass Deployment (as Crew or Ambassador), or served as a Service Platoon Leader. Is this a paid position?

No, all members of the Board of Directors are volunteers and not compensated for their time.

What is the timeline for the application process?

Applications will be open until October 23rd. After that, we'll begin an interview process, and hope to make a final decision by the end of November.

What's the time commitment for the Board?

The Board meets four times per year as a whole board, which includes three virtual meetings and one in-person meeting. The location for the in-person meeting varies each year, and Board members are expected to pay their own travel costs for the in-person board meeting. Additionally, there will occasionally be ad-hoc virtual meetings in between regular gatherings.

What is the financial commitment for the Board?

We expect 100% of board members to make an annual personal financial contribution that is commensurate with capacity.
